**§ A105-1. Promulgation of rules and regulations.**

The Police Chief, with the advice of the Fire Chief and the Public Works Director, is hereby authorized to promulgate rules and regulations for the application and operation of block parties, said rules and regulations to be in compliance with the laws of the State of New Jersey, the County of Camden and the City of Gloucester City.

**§ A105-2. Rules and regulations.**

Said rules and regulations are attached herewith and designated as "Schedule A"<sup>1</sup> and may, from time to time, be amended by the Police Committee of the Mayor and Common Council of Gloucester City upon recommendation from the Police Chief.

## BLOCK PARTIES

### **Schedule A Block Party Regulations**

1. All applications must be made three weeks prior to the closing of the block.
2. All applications must be notarized before being returned.
3. No block party will be legally allowed to operate after 11:00 p.m.
4. A majority of the residents (51%) must be in agreement as to the block being closed.
5. The signatures, addresses and telephone numbers of this majority must be attached to the application when returned.
6. The person(s) signing the application will be responsible for any and all damage that may occur as a result of the block party.
7. No one under the age of 18 will be granted a permit.
8. The applicant will be responsible for closing off the street.
9. No motor vehicles will be used for the blocking of a street.
10. The applicant will also be responsible for the clean up of the block after the party.
11. All state statutes and city ordinances will be adhered to.

**CABLE TELEVISION FRANCHISE**

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Gloucester City, in the County of Camden and State of New Jersey, that:

**§ A110-1. Franchise granted; number of years.**

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Gloucester City, in the County of Camden and State of New Jersey, hereby grants a municipal consent to Clearview Cable Corporation, a corporation of the State of New Jersey, to construct, operate and maintain a cable television service throughout the area of Gloucester City, New Jersey, for a period of fifteen (15) years from the date of the final passage of this ordinance.

**§ A110-2. Terms binding.**

All engagements and representations made by Clearview Cable Corporation in its application for this permit are binding upon the said corporation as terms for the holding and use of this municipal consent.

**§ A110-3. Compliance with statute and certain regulations.**

This municipal consent is issued subject to all the requirements of the statute in such case made and provided and known as the "New Jersey Cable Television Act," and of all the rules, regulations and orders duly promulgated by the Director of the Office of Cable Television of the State of New Jersey.

**§ A110-4. Filing of complaints; complaint officer.**

Complaints by local subscribers to cable television reception service shall be filed directly with the Office of Cable Television of New Jersey and the said Office of Cable Television of New Jersey is hereby determined to be the complaint officer as required by the Cable Television Act.

**§ A110-5. When effective.**

This ordinance shall take effect after final passage and advertisement as required by law and upon the acceptance in writing within ten (10) days after final passage by the applicant of such consent and all the terms and conditions of such consent.
