Community Garden – Mickie is seeking assistance with the chips that someone is leaving on the site of the garden. Could PW assist with moving them around site.

Green Infrastructure Municipal Action Team Business (Toby/Matt/Craig & Rutgers Water Resource Program)

- 319(h) Grant Update – grant ends 5/21
- Matt reported on the schedule for the grant projects:
 - Johnson Boulevard at Water Department building – Completed but flooding is an issue. Matt will stop by on way home from meeting to review. Craig mentioned that possible barrier that we need to break through in soil.
 - GHS project – Craig and Matt issuing contract to Eric's Nursery in Mount Laurel for near \$70,000. Once contracted, schedule will be set for summer 2020.
 - Cherry Street - rain garden - Eric to install diversion for water into garden.
 - May have \$10-\$15K to spend on other projects once final values come in for GHS project – will confirm ideas and make a plan at March meeting.

NJ Tree Foundation - no tree plantings on board yet.

Lori announced that PSE&G trees on Miller Avenue were indeed planted by PSE&G and they will be removing them to install sidewalk. Question is where can we remove and put them. May need Utilities dept. help.
