#### **BLOCK PARTY REGULATIONS**

| 1.  | All applications must be made three (3) weeks prior to the closing of the block.   |

| 2.  | All applications must be notarized before being returned.  |
| 3.  | No block party will be legally allowed to operate after 11:00 P.M.   |
| 4.  | A majority of the residents (51%) must be in agreement as to the block being closed.   |
| 5.  | The signatures, addresses, and telephone numbers of this majority must be attached to the application when returned.             |
| 6.  | The person (s) signing the application will be responsible for any and all damage that may occur as a result of the block party. |
| 7.  | No one under the age of eighteen (18) will be granted a permit.  |
| 8.  | The applicant will be responsible for closing off the street.  |
| 9.  | No motor vehicles will be used for the blocking of a street.   |
| 10. | The applicant will also be responsible for the clean up of the block after the party.  |

# RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF POLICE OF GLOUCESTER CITY TO PROMULGATE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE APPLICATION AND OPERATION OF BLOCK PARTIES

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Common Council of Gloucester City have been approached with requests to operate block parties at various times in the City; and

WHEREAS, said Mayor and Common Council members to not object to such events, given their propensity to foster community relations and friendship among neighbors, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide rules and regulations for such events through the Police, Fire and Public Works Departments of the City for the protection of the health, safety and welfare of our citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of Gloucester City that the Police Chief, with the advice of the Fire Chief and the Public Works Director, is hereby authorized to promulgate rules and regulations for the application and operation of block parties, said rules and regulations to be in compliance with the laws of the State of New Jersey, the County of Camden and the City of Gloucester City.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said rules and regulations are attached herewith and designated as "Schedule A" and may from time to time be amended by the Police Committee of the Mayor and Common Council of Gloucester City upon recommendation from the Police Chief.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this legislation is of significance to the community atlarge and therefore it and any amendments hereto shall be inserted into the Appendix of the City Code as referred to on page v of said code and shall be designated as Chapter A105.
