## RESOLUTION NAMING OFFICIAL DEPOSITORIES/NIGHT DEPOSITORY FOR 2024

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A:5-14 mandates that the governing body of a municipal corporation shall, by resolution passed by a majority vote of the full membership thereof, designate as a depository for its monies a bank or trust company having its place of business in the State and organized under the laws of the United States or this State.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Gloucester City, County of Camden and the State of New Jersey, as follows:

be and are hereby designed as depositories for the City of Gloucester City for the year of 2024.

Prior to the deposit of any municipal funds in the above mentioned depositories, said bank shall file with the City Treasurer a statement indicating that the bank is covered under the Government Units Deposit Protection Act (N.J.S.A. 17:9-41); and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City of Gloucester City is hereby authorized to open a Night Depository Account with TD Bank, Gloucester City, New Jersey; and

**BE IT RESOLVED**, that any Officer of the Corporation be and is hereby authorized to execute and deliver in the name of this Corporation the Night Depository Agreement of TD Bank, (the "Bank") providing for the use by this Corporation of certain Night Depository facilities of the Bank; and

**BE IT RESOLVED**, that any one of the persons authorized to sign checks on any of this Corporation's deposit accounts maintained with the bank, and also any person designated in writing to the bank by the Mayor, City Clerk, Tax Collector or Chief Financial Officer of this Corporation, is authorized for and on behalf of the Corporation to act for this Corporation under and pursuant to the terms of the Agreement.
