## AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF A FAIR AND OPEN CONTRACT FOR MANAGED SERVICE PROVIDER

WHEREAS, a need exists for Specialized Services for Managed Service Provider on behalf of the City of Gloucester City, County of Camden, in the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, Gloucester IT, LLC is authorized to do business in the State of New Jersey, having submitted a response to the City's Request for Proposals pursuant to the New Jersey Local Unit Pay-To-Play Law (N.J.S.A 19:44A-20.4 et seq.); and

WHEREAS, Gloucester IT, LLC has warranted that they stand ready, willing and able to perform all necessary services, are in good standing for the lawful performance of said services within the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to retain Gloucester IT, LLC for the purpose of providing Specialized Services as Managed Service Provider; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A 40A:11-5(1)(a)(i) of the Local Public Contracts Law, this Contract will be awarded without competitive bidding as a "Professional Services" Contract and as such, the Contract itself and the authorizing Resolution will be available for public inspection; and

WHEREAS, the City's Chief Financial Officer has certified that funds are available for this purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Gloucester, County of Camden and State of New Jersey as follows:

1. The provisions of the WHEREAS clauses set forth above are incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof.

- 2. The Mayor and City Clerk, are hereby authorized to execute an Agreement for Professional Services with Gloucester IT, LLC and the Contract shall be consistent with the City's Request for Proposals submitted on November 22, 2023 by Gloucester IT, LLC.
- 3. The term of this Contract shall be for a term of one year.
- 4. This Contract is awarded without competitive bidding as a professional service pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(l)(a)(i) of the Local Public Contracts Law, since the Contract involves services performed by persons authorized by law to practice a recognized profession.
- 5. This resolution shall be published as required by law.
