RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GLOUCESTER CITY, COUNTY OF CAMDEN, AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT OF SALE BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF GLOUCESTER CITY AND PNC BANK AND ITS AFFILIATES, SUBJECT TO CERTAIN TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Long., Jr., Esquire and Vanessa Little, RMC, City Clerk, and/or their respective designees, to execute an Agreement of Sale and undertake all other actions necessary to effectuate said purpose of this Resolution with PNC Bank, in a form to be finally reviewed and approved by way of a formal written opinion by the City Attorney. Said Agreement of Sale shall not be executed unless and until said written approval of the City Attorney is received by the City Clerk.
- 3. The City Attorney is also hereby authorized to complete and submit the "PNC Facility Sale Know Your Buyer Questionnaire" in the form attached hereto and made a part hereof.
- 3. A copy of this Resolution and the final Agreement of Sale to be executed, shall remain on file with the City Clerk for public inspection.
