**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE REGULATING
THE SALARIES OF THE EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF GLOUCESTER CITY,
COUNTY OF CAMDEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Gloucester City, County of Camden and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1: The calendar year 2017 annual salaries for the period January 1, 2017 through and inclusive of December 31, 2017, except as indicated, for the following employees of Gloucester City shall be as follows including any years subject to collective bargaining:

Section B. Municipal Employees

The individuals appointed to these positions are appointed as provided in the statutes of the State of New Jersey to terms and specified for the position and are not covered under the provision of the New Jersey Civil Service Commission as regular appointments. They are entitled to benefits as contained in the ordinance of the City covering non-represented employees and full time employees. Those who are full time employees are entitled to health benefits as provided to the non-represented city employees. These salaries shall be effective on January 1, 2017. No employee may be paid above the maximum and the Governing Body, by Resolution, shall set the amount of annual salary at a rate within the range.

SECTION 2. The salaries specified in Section One (1) of the Ordinance shall be paid in lieu of any salary, bonus, or additional pay for any or all holidays heretofore granted.




