ORDINANCE AMENDING BOND ORDINANCE 7-2011 OF THE CITY OF GLOUCESTER CITY, COUNTY OF CAMDEN, NEW JERSEY

BACKGROUND

WHEREAS, the City of Gloucester City, County of Camden, New Jersey ("City") has heretofore duly and finally adopted Bond Ordinance 7-2011, authorizing various improvements to the Sewer and Water Utility System in and for the City ("Bond Ordinance"); and

WHEREAS, the City has completed the project set forth in Section 7(B) of the Bond Ordinance and has remaining unspent funds in the amount of \$223,519 ("Unspent Funds"); and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to reappropriate the Unspent Funds to finance Various Repaving and Utility Improvements on 5th Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL (NOT LESS THAN TWO-THIRDS OF ALL THE MEMBERS THEREOF AFFIRMATIVELY CONCURRING), PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE LOCAL BOND LAW, CHAPTER 169 OF THE LAWS OF 1960 OF THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED ("LOCAL BOND LAW"), AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 7. of the Bond Ordinance is hereby amended to provide as follows:

"Section 7. The improvements hereby authorized and the purposes for which said obligations are to be issued; the estimated costs of each said purpose; the amount of down payment for each said purpose; the maximum amount obligations to be issued for each said purpose and the period of usefulness of each said purpose within the limitations of the Local Bond Law are as follows:

Section 2. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the regulations promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail the amended capital budget and capital improvement program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services, New Jersey Department of Community Affairs, are on file with the City Clerk and available for public inspection.

Section 3. All other parts of the Bond Ordinance not amended hereby shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. In accordance with the Local Bond Law, this ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after the first publication thereof after final passage.
