**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE REGULATING
THE SALARIES OF THE EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF GLOUCESTER CITY,
COUNTY OF CAMDEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Gloucester City, County of Camden and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1: The calendar year 2019 annual salaries for the period October 21, 2019 through and inclusive of December 31, 2019, except as indicated, for the following employees of Gloucester City shall be as follows including any years subject to collective bargaining:

Section B. Municipal Employees


The individuals appointed to these positions are appointed as provided in the statutes of the State of New Jersey to terms and specified for the position and are not covered under the provision of the New Jersey Civil Service Commission as regular appointments. They are entitled to benefits as contained in the ordinance of the City covering non-represented employees and full time employees. Those who are full time employees are entitled to health benefits as provided to the non-represented city employees. This salary shall be effective on October 21, 2019. No employee may be paid above the maximum and the Governing Body, by Resolution, shall set the amount of annual salary at a rate within the range.

SECTION 2. The salaries specified in Section One (1) of the Ordinance shall be paid in lieu of any salary, bonus, or additional pay for any or all holidays heretofore granted.


SECTION 3. All Ordinances or Resolutions or parts thereof, inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same are hereby repealed, but only to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4. All salaries specified in this ordinance shall take effect as of final adoption and shall continue in effect until and amendment to this ordinance or passage of any ordinance inconsistent with this ordinance.
