## ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF PROPERTY

Whereas, Gloucester City owns property located at 344 Middlesex Street, know as Block 36, lot 33; and

Whereas, Gloucester City has no current use for the property; and

Whereas, Gloucester City has notified the adjoining property owners of the availability of the property; and

Whereas, the Gloucester City tax assessor has determined the value of the property in "as is" condition is worth no more than \$2,500.00;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Gloucester City, County of Camden, State of New Jersey:

- 1. The Mayor and the Clerk are authorized to enter into an agreement to sell 344 Middlesex Street to George J. Pipito, Jr., for \$2,500.00 under the following conditions, and, if all conditions are met, to execute the appropriate deed and other conveyance documents;
  - a. George J. Pipito, Jr., shall execute an agreement of sale prepared by the Gloucester City Solicitor, the cost of which shall be borne by George J. Pipito, Jr.;
  - The property is being sold in "as is" conditions and Gloucester
     City makes no warranties' other than it has the right to sell the property;
  - c. George J. Pipito, Jr., shall indemnify Gloucester City for claims asserted after the sale;

- d. The Solicitor for the City of Gloucester shall prepare the deed and other conveyance documents, the cost of which shall be borne by George J. Pipito, Jr.,;
- e. Settlement shall take place within twenty (20) days of the adoption of this Ordinance;
- f. George J. Pipito, Jr., shall provide Gloucester City with a title report, containing the recital of how Gloucester City acquired title and the legal description of the property;
- g. Gloucester City shall bear no expenses or costs for this transaction.
- 2. The Mayor is authorized to execute the agreement of sale, deed, affidavits and any other documents necessary to complete the closing and transfer the property.
