### RESOLUTION ADOPTING TEMPORARY BUDGET CITY OF GLOUCESTER CITY, COUNTY OF CAMDEN TEMPORARY BUDGET APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE YEAR 2017

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-19 provides that where any contract, commitment or payments are to be made prior to the final adoption of the 2016 budget, temporary appropriations should be made for purposes and amounts required in the manner and time therein provided; and

WHEREAS, the date of the Resolution is within the first thirty days of January, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the total appropriations in the 2016 budget, exclusive of any appropriations made for interest and debt redemption charges, capital improvement fund and public assistance, is the sum of \$18,747,737.50 for the General Fund and \$3,191,800.00 for the Water and Sewer Utility Fund, and

WHEREAS, twenty-six and twenty-five one hundredths percent (26.25%) of the total appropriations in the 2016 budget exclusive of any appropriations made for interest and debt service, public assistance and capital improvement fund in the said 2016 budget is \$4,921,281.09 for the General Fund and \$837,847.50 for the Water and Sewer Utility and.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Gloucester City, County of Camden, State of New Jersey that the following temporary budget appropriations for 2017 be made and that a certified copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the Chief Financial Officer for his records.
