**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING INTERLOCAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH  
VARIOUS SOUTH JERSEY MUNICIPALITIES FOR THE SALE OF BRINE**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Gloucester City has the means of producing brine, specifically containing 23.3% NaCl with a – 6.0 degrees freeze point; and

**WHEREAS**, the City is able to provide amounts beyond what it presently needs; and


**WHEREAS**, the Buyers, Borough of Westville, Borough of Oaklyn, Borough of Audubon, Borough of Runnemede, Borough of Bellmawr, Borough of Barrington, Borough of Mt. Ephraim, City of Camden and Collingswood Board of Education have a need for brine.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Governing Body of the City of Gloucester City hereby agrees to sell Buyers such quantity of brine as the Buyer may require at a cost of \$.42 per gallon.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a an Interlocal Services Agreement with the above municipalities to provide for this service.
