RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLOUCESTER CITY AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION TO THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS FOR THE RESURFACING OF THE JOGGING TRAIL AT JOHNSON PARK

- WHEREAS, the City of Gloucester City has determined that the current jogging trail at Johnson Park, while well-maintained by the Borough's Department of Public Works, has extended beyond its useful life and presents safety hazards to those who use the trail; and
- WHEREAS, the City of Gloucester City has determined that the development of this project will have a positive and significant impact on the quality of life for City residents; and
- WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs has funding available through the Local Recreation Improvement Grant program which could fund this project; and
- WHEREAS, the City of Gloucester City desires to apply for and obtain a grant from the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs not to exceed \$200,000 to carry out a project to resurface the jogging trail at Johnson Park.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,

- 1. that the City of Gloucester City does hereby authorize the application for such a grant; and,
- 2. that the City of Gloucester City recognizes and accepts that the Department may offer a lesser or greater amount and therefore, upon receipt of the grant agreement from the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs, does further authorize the execution of any such grant agreement; and also, upon receipt of the fully executed agreement from the Department, does further authorize the expenditure of funds pursuant to the terms of the agreement between the City of Gloucester City and the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs.
