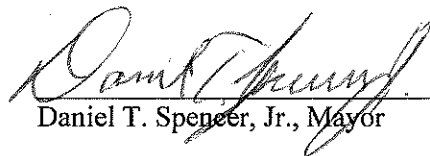
WHEREAS, the City Assessor has reviewed the subject parcels and has rendered a value, based upon the current conditions as follows:

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Common Council of the City desire to establish a minimum bid price for the parcels set forth herein.

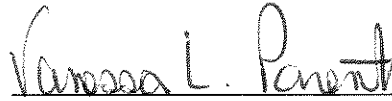

King Street Vacant Lot (Block: 54, Lot: 5) shall be advertised for public sale pursuant to all procedural and substantive requirements of the Local Lands and Buildings Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:12-1 et seq.) in a form to be drafted and prepared by the City Solicitor for the minimum sums set forth hereinabove.
