**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENT OF RESOURCE CONTROL  
CONSULTANTS, LLC (“RCC” AND/OR “JEFF DEY”) AS THE CITY’S LICENSED SITE  
REMEDATION PROFESSIONAL (“LSRP”) FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING SITE  
MAINTENANCE RAD MONITORING SERVICES FOR THE GTC-CBS SITE,  
SOUTHPORT BDA, GLOUCESTER CITY, NEW JERSEY**


**WHEREAS**, the City of Gloucester City (“City”) is in need of certain specialized environmental services, specifically a Licensed Site Remediation Professional (“LSRP”); and

**WHEREAS**, the Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1, et seq.) requires that the resolution authorizing the award of contracts for professional services without competitive bids, and the contract itself, must be available for public inspection; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Gloucester City have determined that it would be advantageous for the City to engage Resource Control Consultants, L.L.C. (“RCC” and/or “Jeff Dey”) as its Licensed Site Remediation Professional (“LSRP”) for the purpose of providing site maintenance RAD monitoring services.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Gloucester City, County of Camden, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. The provisions of the **WHEREAS** clauses set forth above are incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof.
2. The City of Gloucester City is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Resource Control Consultants, L.L.C. (“RCC” and/or “Jeff Dey”) as its Licensed Site Remediation Professional (“LSRP”) for the purpose of providing site maintenance RAD monitoring services for a period of one (1) year commencing on February 18, 2021 and expiring on February 17, 2022.
3. The aforesaid contract is awarded without competitive bidding as a “Professional Service” under the provisions of the Local Public Contracts Law in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5 which requires that no local unit shall be required to advertise for bids for services rendered or performed by a person in a recognized professional service, whose practice is regulated by law.
4. This Resolution shall be published in the official newspaper of the City of Gloucester City as required by law.
