NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of

reference and made a part hereof.

2. The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Gloucester hereby authorize a 9:00 a.m. opening

for the sale from local bars and restaurants for alcoholic beverage on March 3rd & March 17, 2019.
