TO REPUBLIC SERVICES OF NJ, LLC

WHEREAS, the City of Gloucester City ("City") advertised for public bids for the contract for Collection & Disposal of Solid Waste & Recyclable Materials;

WHEREAS, the City furnished detailed Bid Specifications to potential bidders; and

WHEREAS, three (3) bids for the contract for the Collection & Disposal of Solid Waste & Recyclable Materials were received and opened on January 8, 2020, as follows:

WHEREAS, the apparent low bidder for this contract is Republic Services of NJ, LLC ("Republic"); and

WHEREAS, the City Solicitor has rendered a legal opinion dated January 23, 2020 recommending the award of the contract to Republic as they are the lowest responsible bidder; and


WHEREAS, the City Administrator, Mayor and Common Council of the City of Gloucester City concur with the above recommendation and desire to award the contract to Republic.

2. The contract for Collection & Disposal of Solid Waste & Recyclable Materials is hereby awarded to Republic Services of NJ, LLC.


3. The Mayor, City Administrator and/or their designees are hereby directed to take any and all steps necessary to effectuate the award and execution of the aforementioned contract.
