**AUTHORIZING ALL PLENARY RETAIL CONSUMPTION LICENSE ESTABLISHMENTS
TO EXTEND HOURS OF OPERATION**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Gloucester ("City") desire to extend the normal hours of operation for all plenary retail consumption license establishments, specifically for Sunday, March 5, 2017 and Sunday, March 12, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police of the City has reviewed the request and issued an approval thereof; and


WHEREAS, in accordance with Ordinance §15-3A, entitled, "Hours of Sale" provides that hours of sale for bars and restaurants for alcoholic beverage is restricted from 12:00 noon Sunday until 2:00 a.m. Monday; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to permit an early opening on the identified dates set forth herein at 10:00 a.m., rather than 12:00 noon as set forth in the City Code; and

WHEREAS, the City believes assisting such community events and programs such as the St. Mary's Irish Month Activities which features, among other activities, the Sunday, March 5, 2017 Irish Parade as well as the Sunday, March 12, 2017 Irish 5K Run and Walk, serves to enhance and embrace the City's heritage, develops pride within the community and is truly in the best interest of all residents of the City of Gloucester; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Gloucester, County of Camden and State of New Jersey as follows:
