**WHEREAS**, Remington & Vernick Engineers, the City Engineer, has been engaged to prosecute the said application on behalf of the City; and


**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council wish to formally confirm the authority of Jack Lipsett, City Administrator to represent the City for the said purposes;
