RESOLUTION DESIGNATING HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACES:
ADDING 324 HUNTER STREET & 226 N. BROADWAY

WHEREAS, it is necessary to designate handicapped parking spaces; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Gloucester City, pursuant to the authority granted to this municipality by N.J.S.A. 39:4-197.5, and other statutory authority that the location designated on the attached Schedule A is hereby designated as restrictive parking space for use by any person who has been issued a special vehicle identification card by the Division of Motor Vehicles.

No other person shall be permitted to park in these spaces. Any person parking a motor vehicle in a restricted parking space without a special vehicle identification card shall be subject to penalty pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-197 (3)(c). This resolution is passed in conformance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39:4-197 (3)(c). Proper signs are to be erected regarding the said spaces.




