TO CERTAIN TERMS AND CONDITIONS**


**WHEREAS**, the City of Gloucester ("City") has received an Encroachment Agreement ("Agreement") from Colonial Pipeline as part of the remedial action being undertaken with respect to the Southport Redevelopment Area; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has forwarded the Agreement to the City Solicitor for legal review and consideration; and


**WHEREAS**, the Solicitor, by letter dated March 11, 2016, has reviewed the Agreement and made certain recommendations prior to the execution thereof by the Mayor.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Gloucester, County of Camden and State of New Jersey as follows:

1. The provisions of the WHEREAS clauses set forth above are incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof.
2. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute the Encroachment Agreement upon the final review and written authorization by the City Solicitor.
