RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE BOROUGH OF HADDON HEIGHTS AND THE CITY OF GLOUCESTER CITY FOR VARIOUS CODE OFFICIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSBILITIES IN ACCORDANCE WITH N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 ET SEQ.

WHEREAS, Haddon Heights and the City desire to enter into a separate Shared Services Agreement ("Agreement") pursuant to the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act (N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq.) ("Shared Services Act"), whereby Haddon Heights shares the services of its Construction Official and Electrical Sub-Code, Edward Gorman, with the City at no extra cost to Haddon Heights; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to use the services of Edward Gorman to perform Electric Code
Official and Code Enforcement Officer duties on a part time basis which it only shall be paid directly to
Edward Gorman; and

WHEREAS, under the Shared Services Act, any local unit may enter into an agreement with any other local unit or units to provide or receive any service that each local unit participating in the agreement is empowered to provide or receive within its own jurisdiction, including services incidental to the primary purposes of any of the participating local units; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution adopted on March 15, 2022, Haddon authorized the execution of this Agreement with the City for the services aforesaid services; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution adopted March 15, 2022, the City authorized the execution of this Agreement with Haddon Heights for the services aforesaid; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Gloucester City in the County of Camden and State of New Jersey as follows:

- 1. The provisions of the WHEREAS clauses set forth above are incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof.
- 2. The Mayor and/or Council to take any and all actions necessary to execute a Shared Services Agreement by and between the City of Gloucester and the Borough of Haddon Heights and perform all other functions to effectuate the purposes thereof.
- 3. The Agreement shall be attached to this Resolution upon execution and kept on file in the Office of the City Clerk of the City of Gloucester City.

- 4. The subject Shared Services Agreement shall be filed, for informational purposes, with the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs, pursuant to rules and regulations promulgated by the Director.
- 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
