A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GLOUCESTER CITY, COUNTY OF CAMDEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION, SITE REMEDIATION AND WASTE MANAGEMENT PROGRAM, NOTICE OF MANDATORY OR EXPEDIATED SITE-SPECIFIC REMEDIATION TIMEFRAME FORM BY BRIAN MORRELL, DULY AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE OF THE CITY OF GLOUCESTER CITY

WHEREAS, the City of Gloucester City ("City") has received from its duly appointed New Jersey Licensed Site Remediation Professional ("LSRP"), Notice of Mandatory or Expediated Site-Specific Remediation Timeframe Form review and execution thereof; and

WHEREAS, the City including the Mayor and Common Council and City Attorney have reviewed the document and desire to authorize Brian Morrell to execute same upon the advice and guidance of its LSRP and City Attorney; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Gloucester City have determined that it is in the best interest and welfare of the citizens of the City to execute said document attached hereto and made a part hereof; and


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Gloucester City, as follows:

1. The provisions of the **WHEREAS** clauses set forth above are incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof.
2. The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Gloucester City hereby formally authorizes Brian Morrell to execute and transmit, the Notice of Mandatory or Expediated Site-Specific Remediation Timeframe Form, and carry out all other actions necessary to effectuate said purpose of said documents.
3. A copy of this Resolution and final subject Notice of Mandatory or Expediated Site-Specific Remediation Timeframe Form to be executed shall remain on file with the City Clerk for public inspection.
4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
