



**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GLOUCESTER CITY
RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF THE CONTRACT FOR THE GAC
FILTRATION SYSTEM TO CALGON CARBON CORPORATION PURSUANT TO
N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(gg).

WHEREAS, the City of Gloucester City (“City”) required a GAC Filtration System for use as a water filtration system; and

WHEREAS, under the Local Public Contracts law, specifically N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(gg) the City is permitted to negotiate a contract without public advertising for bids and bidding therefor, and award said contract by resolution of the governing body if the subject matter thereof consists of a contract for the provision of water supply services or wastewater treatment services entered into pursuant to section 2 of P.L.2002, c. 47 (C.40A:11-5.1), or the designing, financing, construction, operation, or maintenance, or any combination thereof, of a water supply facility as defined in subsection (16) of section 15 of P.L.1971, c. 198 (C.40A:11-15) or a wastewater treatment system as defined in subsection (19) of section 15 of P.L.1971, c. 198 (C.40A:11-15), or any component part or parts thereof, including a water filtration system as defined in subsection (16) of section 15 of P.L.1971, c. 198 (C.40A:11-15); and

WHEREAS, via correspondence dated April 17, 2020, the City Solicitor provided a legal opinion that the contract for GAC Filtration System did fall under the exception to bidding as provided within N.J.S.A 40A:11-5(1)(gg) and therefore could be negotiated and awarded via resolution by the City; and


WHEREAS, the City has negotiated and received a quotation from Calgon Carbon Corporation in the total amount of \$550,135.00 in a form attached to and made apart hereof; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer and Superintendent of the City’s Environmental Utilities/Water & Sewer Department have reviewed the quotation and recommend the award of the contract to Calgon Carbon Corporation; and


WHEREAS, the City Administrator, Mayor and Common Council of the City of Gloucester City concur with the above recommendation and desire to award the contract to Calgon Carbon Corporation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Gloucester City, County of Camden, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. The provisions of the **WHEREAS** clauses set forth above are incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof.
2. The contract for GAC Filtration System is hereby awarded to Calgon Carbon Corporation in the total amount of \$550,135.00 in the form of the quotation received and made a part hereof pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(gg).
3. The Mayor, City Administrator and/or their designees are hereby directed to take any and all steps necessary to effectuate the award and execution of the aforementioned contract.
4. Funds are available for payment of this Contract.
