RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ENDORSEMENT AND CONSENT OF TREATMENT WORKS APPROVAL APPLICATION


WHEREAS, Public Laws of 1970, Chapter 33, established the Department of Environmental Protection in the State of New Jersey ("NJDEP"); and

WHEREAS, the NJDEP shall approve certain plans and specifications for the construction, alternations, extension and improvements to waterworks, water distribution systems, construction of sewerage and/or industrial waste treatment works, extensions of sanitary sewer systems and the diversion of sub-surface waters for public water supplies and for permits for constructing of bridges, culverts, stream encroachment or modifications; and


WHEREAS, it is required that standard application form TWA-1 be filed with the NJDEP, Division of Water Quality along with the required plans and specifications, where these are to be operated by the City of Gloucester City.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Gloucester City, County of Camden and State of New Jersey, that:

1. The provisions of the **WHEREAS** clauses set forth above are incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof.
2. The Director Department of Utilities, Eric G. Fooder, CPWM, is hereby authorized to sign such applications on behalf of the City of Gloucester City for all such works conditioned upon his review and approval of the same.
3. The Director Department of Utilities, Eric G. Fooder, CPWM, is hereby authorized to sign such applications for such works to be Welsbach/GGM Superfund Site: Former Welsbach Facility Groundwater Treatment Facility conditioned further upon the City of Gloucester City bearing no responsibility for all spills, contaminations, and the like, associated with this project.
4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
