RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT AND RATIFYING OF A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF GLOUCESTER CITY AND THE GLOUCESTER CITY SUPERIOR FIRE OFFICER'S ASSOCIATION, FMBA LOCAL NO. 251, INC., SUBJECT TO CERTAIN TERMS AND CONDITIONS, FOR THE PERIOD COMMENCING JANUARY 1, 2019 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2023

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Gloucester City have negotiated. through the City Solicitor, a Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") which shall form the basis of a Collective Bargaining Agreement with the Gloucester City Superior Fire Officer's Association, FMBA Local No. 251, Inc., subject to certain terms and conditions for the period covering January 1, 2019 through December 31, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Common Council desire to approve the Memorandum of Understanding and ratify said Collective Bargaining Agreement ("CBA") and authorize the Mayor to execute the said documents between the parties.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Gloucester City, County of Camden and State of New Jersey, that:

- 1. The provisions of the WHEREAS clauses set forth above are incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof.
- 2. The Mayor and Common Council hereby authorizing the execution of a MOU and ratifying of a CBA, consistent therewith by and between the City of Gloucester City and the Gloucester City Superior Fire Officer's Association, FMBA Local No. 251, Inc., subject to certain terms and conditions, for the period commencing January 1, 2019 through December 31, 2023, subject to the final approval of the City Solicitor as to the final form of the Collective bargaining Agreement.
- 3. The Mayor, Business Administrator, City Solicitor and/or Chief Financial Officer are hereby authorized to take any action to achieve the purposes set forth herein.
- The authorization of the MOU and ratification of the CBA is expressly conditioned upon 4. the adoption of an appropriate and necessary salary ordinance reflecting the fiscal changes set forth within the CBA.

5. The Chief Financial Officer shall certify as to the availability of funds and this Resolution shall take effect upon adoption of the salary ordinance identified herein.
