WHEREAS, NJSA 40A:65-1 authorizes local units of government to enter into agreements for shared services; and

WHEREAS, Middlesex Regional Education Commission as the Lead Agency shall be responsible for complying with the Local Public Contracts Law, NJSA40A:11-1 et seq. and all other provision of the revised statutes of the State of New Jersey,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of Gloucester City that the proper officers are hereby authorized to enter into a Shared Services Agreement with Middlesex Regional Education Commission of New Jersey with respect to the delivery of good and services through cooperative purchasing program.
