RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH GLOUCESTER CATHOLIC HIGH SCHOOL FOR THE SUPPLY OF DIESEL FUEL AND OTHER FUEL FOR THE BUSES

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq., the City of Gloucester City is authorized to enter into an agreement for shared services; and

WHEREAS, Gloucester Catholic High School and the City of Gloucester City are desirous of entering into a Shared Services Agreement ("Agreement") pursuant to the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act (N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq.) ("Shared Services Act"), whereby the City of Gloucester City would provide diesel fuel and other fuel for the buses of Gloucester Catholic High School at costs, including all applicable taxes and surcharges; and

WHEREAS, under the Shared Services Act, any local unit may enter into an agreement with any other local unit or units to provide or receive any service that each local unit participating in the agreement is empowered to provide or receive within its own jurisdiction, including services incidental to the primary purposes of any of the participating local units; and

WHEREAS, a Shared Services Agreement between the City of Gloucester City and Gloucester Catholic High School has been prepared setting forth the terms and conditions of the Agreement between the City and the High School; and

WHEREAS, the Shared Services Agreement incorporates all of the terms of the agreement between the parties; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the Common Council finds that it is in the best interests of the residents of the City of Gloucester City to enter into the Shared Services Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the Common Council of the City of Gloucester City as follows:

1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a Shared Services Agreement for the supply of diesel fuel and other fuel to Gloucester Catholic High School.
2. The Shared Services Agreement shall be placed on file in the office of the Clerk of the City of Gloucester City.
3. The Clerk of the City of Gloucester City is hereby authorized and directed to provide a certified copy of this Resolution and a copy of the fully executed Agreement to the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs and to the Department of Environmental Protection for informational purposes.
