RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE RENTAL LICENSE
ISSUED TO JOSEPH AYERS
FOR 336 MIDDLESEX STREET

RESOLUTION # 135-2017

WHEREAS, a complaint was filed alleging a violation of Chapter 55 of the Code of the City of Gloucester involving property located at 336 Middlesex Street, owned by Joseph Ayers seeking revocation of the owners right to rent the aforementioned property; and

WHEREAS, a hearing concerning the charge was held on April 27, 2017, before a hearing officer designated by Council, which property owner was given notice of the opportunity to confront and cross examine witnesses and present evidence; and


WHEREAS, the hearing officer heard testimony, reviewed evidence and made findings and a recommendation; and

WHEREAS, the property owner was provided with a copy of the hearing officer's recommendation, copies of all the evidence, said recommendation being based on the testimony and the documents submitted; and

WHEREAS, the property owner was afforded the opportunity to address Mayor and Council at a hearing conducted on May 18, 2017; and


WHEREAS, Mayor and Council considered all the information presented,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Rental License issued to Joseph Ayers is placed on a one (1) year probationary period effective April 27, 2017. If there are further violations the matter will be re-listed for revocation.
