**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A PERSON-TO-PERSON TRANSFER OF PLENARY
RETAIL CONSUMPTION LIQUOR LICENSE 0414-33-001-011**

WHEREAS, an application has been filed for a Person-to-Person Transfer of Plenary Retail Consumption License Number 0414-33-001-011, heretofore issued to South Jersey Tavern Associates, LLC and

WHEREAS, the submitted application form is complete in all respects, and the transfer fees have been paid; and

WHEREAS, the applicant is qualified to be licensed according to all standards established by Title 33 of the New Jersey Statutes, regulations promulgated thereunder, as well as pertinent local ordinances and conditions consistent with Title 33; and


WHEREAS, the applicant has disclosed and the Common Council of Gloucester City has reviewed the source of all funds used in the purchase of the license and the licensed business and all additional financing obtained in connection with the licensed business; and

WHEREAS, the applicant has published a notice of application in the Gloucester City News, said notice appearing in both the June 9th and 16th, 2016 editions of said newspaper, and the City Clerk has not received a written objection thereto.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Gloucester City, County of Camden, State of New Jersey that Plenary Retail Consumption License Number 0414-33-001-011 issued to South Jersey Tavern Associates, LLC, be transferred to Ischa Y. Santiago. The effective date of the transfer is nunc pro tunc to June 30, 2016.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this license is now a pocket license and is considered inactive.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Kathleen M. Jentsch, Acting City Clerk, is hereby authorized to execute the endorsement of said transfer and directed to keep said license in her possession until such time that a place to place transfer application is submitted and approved by action of the Governing Body.
