## RESOLUTION: #R/60 -2016

# RESOLUTION REQUESTING PERMISSION OF THE DIRECTOR OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT SERVICES TO ANTICIPATE SPECIAL ITEM OF REVENUE IN THE 2016 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF GLOUCESTER CITY PURSUANT TO 40A:4-87 (CHAPTER 159, P.L. 1948)

WHEREAS, 40A:4-87 authorizes a municipality to anticipate a special item of revenue and appropriate such revenue with the consent of the Director of Local Government Services when such item shall have been made available by law and the amount thereof shall not have been determined at the time of the adoption of the budget, and

WHEREAS, the City of Gloucester City has been awarded a \$7,000.00 Emergency Management Assistance Sub-award Grant from the New Jersey Department of Law and Public Safety, Office of the Attorney General, State Police Office of Emergency Management, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Gloucester City desire to anticipate and appropriate the revenue in the 2016 Annual Budget for the benefit of the citizens of Gloucester City;

### SECTION 1

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Gloucester City, County of Camden, that the Director of the Division of Local Government Services be and is hereby requested to approve the insertion of an item of revenue in the budget of the year 2016 in the sum of \$7,000.00 which item is now available as a revenue from the New Jersey Department of Law and Public Safety, Division of State Police, Office of Emergency Management and

#### **SECTION 2**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the like sum of \$7,000.00 is hereby appropriated under the caption of Homeland Security Emergency Management Performance Grant Program FY15-EMPG-EMAA-0414, and

### **SECTION 3**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the sum of \$7,000.00 representing the in-kind amount required for the City's share of the aforementioned undertaking or improvement appears in the budget for the Year 2016 under the caption "Office of Emergency Management – Salaries and Wages".
