RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING STATE CONTRACT FOR PURCHASE OF SEVENTY (70) SELF CONTAINED BREATHING APPRATUS (SCBA) AND RELATED EQUIPMENT FOR THE GLOUCESTER CITY FIRE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Gloucester City wishes to go into a shared service agreement with Borough of Mount Ephraim and Westville Fire District for this purchase and;

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A 40A:65-1 authorizes local units of government to enter into agreements for shared services; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to purchase Seventy (70) Self Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA) and Related Equipment from an authorized vendor under the State of New Jersey Cooperative Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of goods and services by local contracting unit is authorized by the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-12; and

WHEREAS, Nat Alexander Company, A Division of Mid-Atlantic Fire and Air, 121 North White Horse Pike, Laurel Springs, NJ 08021-1648 has been awarded New Jersey State Contact No. A-80961 for the period beginning April 1, 2012 and still in effective due State extension

WHEREAS, the Fire Department recommends the utilization of this contract on the grounds it represents the best price available; and

WHEREAS, the actual cost for the purchase is expected not to exceed \$522,452.00 Seventy (70) Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus and Related Equipment


WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified the availability of funds for this contract, as evidenced by the attached certificate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of Gloucester City, Camden County, New Jersey that


