

**RESOLUTION: # R 162 -2016**

**RESOLUTION REQUESTING PERMISSION OF THE DIRECTOR OF LOCAL  
GOVERNMENT SERVICES TO ANTICIPATE SPECIAL ITEM OF REVENUE IN THE  
2016 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF GLOUCESTER CITY PURSUANT TO 40A:4-87  
(CHAPTER 159, P.L. 1948)**

**WHEREAS**, 40A:4-87 authorizes a municipality to anticipate a special item of revenue and appropriate such revenue with the consent of the Director of Local Government Services when such item shall have been made available by law and the amount thereof shall not have been determined at the time of the adoption of the budget, and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Gloucester City has been awarded a \$57,143.00 Assistance to Firefighters Grant from the United States Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Gloucester City desire to anticipate and appropriate the revenue in the 2016 Annual Budget for the benefit of the citizens of Gloucester City;

**SECTION 1**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Gloucester City, County of Camden, that the Director of the Division of Local Government Services be and is hereby requested to approve the insertion of an item of revenue in the budget of the year 2016 in the sum of \$57,143.00 which item is now available as a revenue from the United States Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), and

**SECTION 2**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the like sum of \$57,143.00 is hereby appropriated under the caption of United States Federal Emergency Management Agency – Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program, Award No. EMW-2015-FO-07035, and


**SECTION 3**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the sum of \$2,857.00 representing the amount required for the City's share of the aforementioned undertaking or improvement appears in the budget for the Year 2016 under the caption "Fire – Other Expenses", and

**SECTION 4**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the above is the result of a grant awarded by the United States Federal Emergency Management Agency.
