WHEREAS, the City of Gloucester City is the owner of the following surplus equipment which is no longer needed for public use: **Schooner North Wind:**



WHEREAS, the City of Gloucester City desires to authorize the sale of this surplus equipment at a public sale pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-36, to the highest bidder;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Gloucester City, County of Camden and State of New Jersey as follows:

1. The provisions of the **WHEREAS** clauses set forth above are incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof.
2. The City of Gloucester City hereby declares that the surplus equipment is no longer needed for public use and establishes a minimum bid price of \$50,000, subject to certain terms and conditions to be set for in the advertisement of sale.
3. The City of Gloucester City and its officers are hereby authorized and directed to take any and all steps necessary to proceed with a public sale of said surplus equipment.
4. The notice of the date, time and place of the public sale together with a description of the surplus equipment and the conditions of sale, shall be published in the official newspaper of the City of Gloucester City, with the sale being held not less than seven (7) nor more than fourteen (14) days after the publication of said notice.
