WHEREAS, by Resolution #118-2017, the rental privileges issued to Magdi Yousef were revoked permanently; and


WHEREAS, a secondary hearing was held on August 3, 2017 at 3:00 p.m. before a hearing officer designated by Council, which property owner was given notice of the opportunity to confront and cross examine witnesses and present evidence, by certified and regular mail, the property owner did appear and testified and extenuating circumstances were presented in evidence by Mr. Yousef and his attorney; and

WHEREAS, the hearing officer heard testimony, reviewed evidence and made findings and a recommendation; and

WHEREAS, the property owner was provided with a copy of the hearing officer's recommendation, copies of all the evidence, said recommendation being based on the testimony and the documents submitted, and


WHEREAS, Mayor and Council considered all the information presented,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Rental Registration Permit issued to Magdi Yousef is place on a probationary status for a period of one year commencing August 3, 2017.
