WHEREAS, a hearing concerning the charge was held on August 3, 2017 at 3:00 p.m. before a hearing officer designated by Council, which property owner was given notice of the opportunity to confront and cross examine witnesses and present evidence, by certified and regular mail, the property owner did appear and testified; and

WHEREAS, the hearing officer heard testimony, reviewed evidence and made findings and a recommendation; and

WHEREAS, the property owner was provided with a copy of the hearing officer's recommendation, copies of all the evidence, said recommendation being based on the testimony and the documents submitted, and

WHEREAS, Mayor and Council considered all the information presented,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Rental Registration Permit issued to Gustavo Firpri, Jr. will remain intake but Gustavo Firpi, Jr., shall be on probation for a period of one year commencing August 3, 2017, further resolved that Mr. Firpi shall improve his screening of tenants and shall actively manage the property instead, so that the tenants who has created problems as in the past will be dealt with appropriately.
