

RESOLUTION: # R 257 -2016

**RESOLUTION REQUESTING PERMISSION OF THE DIRECTOR OF LOCAL  
GOVERNMENT SERVICES TO ANTICIPATE SPECIAL ITEM OF REVENUE IN THE 2016  
BUDGET OF THE CITY OF GLOUCESTER CITY PURSUANT TO 40A:4-87  
(CHAPTER 159, P.L. 1948)**

**WHEREAS**, 40A:4-87 authorizes a municipality to anticipate a special item of revenue and appropriate such revenue with the consent of the Director of Local Government Services when such item shall have been made available by law and the amount thereof shall not have been determined at the time of the adoption of the budget, and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Gloucester City has been awarded a \$1,800.00 Cops in Shops College Fall Initiative 2016-17 Grant (Grant No. AL-17-45-05-01) from the New Jersey Office of the Attorney General, Department of Law and Public Safety, Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control, and funding provided by the United States Department of Transportation, National Highway Traffic Safety Administration; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Gloucester City desire to anticipate and appropriate the revenue in the 2016 Annual Budget for the benefit of the citizens of Gloucester City;

SECTION 1

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Gloucester City, County of Camden, that the Director of the Division of Local Government Services be and is hereby requested to approve the insertion of an item of revenue in the budget of the year 2016 in the sum of \$1,800.00 which item is now available as a revenue from the State of New Jersey Department of Law and Public Safety, Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control, Grant No. AL-17-45-05-01; and

SECTION 2

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the like sum of \$1,800.00 is hereby appropriated under the caption of New Jersey Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control – Cops in Shops College Fall Initiative 2016-17; and


SECTION 3
