RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A RIGHT OF ENTRY AGREEMENT FOR THE GLOUCESTER CITY MIDDLE SCHOOL INFRASTRUCTURE AND PEDESTRIAN SAFETY IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, under the Federal Highway Administration funding procedures, the Local Public Agency is required to certify that they either own the property where the work is being performed or they have a legal right to work on said property; and

WHEREAS, the proposed improvements for the Middle School Infrastructure and Pedestrian Safety Improvement project requires one (1) temporary construction easement also referred to as a Right of Entry Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the construction activity requiring the Right of Entry Agreement is located at the northeast corner of the intersection of Jersey Avenue and 5th Street in the City of Gloucester City (City"), and is owned by the City; and

WHEREAS, in conjunction with an upcoming construction project requires the altering of the curb ramp and sidewalk which crosses the property line to Lot 3.01 and Block 94.01 in conformance with the attached curb ramp alteration plan which requires a temporary entry onto the property for approximately two (2) weeks; and

WHEREAS, the City has been informed by the project engineer, Dale Foster, P.E., C.M.E. Assistant Vice President/Senior Project Manager of Greenman-Pedersen, Inc. that there exists no other means of reconstructing the curb ramp so as to conform to ADA requirements without the necessity of a right of entry; and

WHEREAS, the City Solicitor has reviewed and approved as to form, the Lot Owner Right of Entry Agreement attached hereto and made a part hereof; and **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Gloucester City, County of Camden, State of New Jersey as follows:

- .1. The provisions of the **WHEREAS** clauses set forth above are incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof.
- 2. The Mayor and/or City Clerk are hereby authorized to executed the attached Lot Owners Right of Entry Agreement in the form attached hereto, approved by the City Solicitor as to form, and the City's staff are directed to take any and all actions necessary to effectuate the intent of the attached Agreement.
