**RESOLUTION REQUESTING PERMISSION OF THE DIRECTOR OF LOCAL
GOVERNMENT SERVICES TO ANTICIPATE SPECIAL ITEM OF REVENUE IN THE
2022 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF GLOUCESTER CITY PURSUANT TO 40A:4-87
(CHAPTER 159,P.L. 1948)**

WHEREAS, 40A:4-87 authorizes a municipality to anticipate a special item of revenue and appropriate such revenue with the consent of the Local Government Service when such item shall have been made available by law and the amount thereof shall not have been determined at the time of the adoption of the budget, and

WHEREAS, the City of Gloucester City has been awarded a \$89,144.00 Assistance to Firefighters Grant from the United States Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Gloucester City desire to anticipate and appropriate the revenue in the 2022 Annual Budget for the benefit of the citizens of the City of Gloucester City;


WHEREAS, the City of Gloucester City entered into a Shared Service Agreement with Camden City, Collingswood, Bellmawr, Cherry Hill, Westville and it's Fire Departments for this Regional Grant under N.J.S.A 40A:65-1 which authorizes local units of government to enter into agreements for shared services; and
Section 1

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Gloucester City, County of Camden, that the Director of the Division of Local Government Services is hereby requested to approve the insertion of an item of revenue in the budget of the year 2022 in the sum of \$89,144.00 which item is now available as a revenue from the United States Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), and
Section 2


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the like sum of \$89,144.00 is hereby appropriated under the caption of United States Federal Emergency Management Agency-Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program, and
Section 3

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the sum of \$8,914.96 representing the total amount required for the Regional Request among the Departments and Districts; however, Gloucester City is responsible for a sum not exceeding \$3,000 for its share. The aforementioned undertaking or improvement appears in the budget for the Year 2022 under the caption Training and Association Fees (line item 150-521) and/or Dedicated Penalties (line item X-64-155-549)

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above is the result of a regional grant awarded by the United States Federal Emergency Management Agency.
