**Resolution Authorizing Disposal of Surplus Property**


**WHEREAS**, the City of Gloucester City is the owner of certain surplus property which is no longer needed for public use; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Gloucester City is desirous of selling said surplus property in an “as is” condition without express or implied warranties.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City of Gloucester City, as follows:

- (1) The sale of the surplus property shall be conducted through Sourcewell Cooperative Agreement through Gov. Deals pursuant to member # 98243 and GCFD, NJ (4446). The terms and conditions of the agreement entered into with GovDeals is available online at <https://www.govdeals.com/GloucesterCityFire> and also available from the City of Gloucester City.
- (2) The sale will be conducted online and the address of the auction site is govdeals.com. <https://www.govdeals.com/GloucesterCityFire> starting on November 21, 2022
- (3) The sale is being conducted pursuant to Local Finance Notice 2008-9.
- (4) A list of the surplus property to be sold is as follows: A Stanley hydraulic system with a Honda engine, BR67 breaker with attachments, CO25 circular saw with 2 diamond blades and a DS11 chainsaw. A lot of used firefighter turn out gear see attached list
- (5) The surplus property as identified shall be sold in an “as-is” condition without express or implied warranties with the successful bidder required to execute a Hold Harmless and Indemnification Agreement concerning use of said surplus property.
- (6) The City of Gloucester City reserves the right to accept or reject any bid submitted.
