**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING DEMOLITION OF 301 ESSEX STREET, ALSO KNOWN AS  
BLOCK 16, LOT 9, OWNED BY THE CITY OF GLOUCESTER CITY**


**WHEREAS**, the property was inspected by the UCC Construction Official and determined to be an imminent hazard, an unsafe structure and in danger of collapse, and hence recommended that the City either “shore-up” the building or demolish same; and

**WHEREAS**, City Housing Department concurred with the inspection results performed by the UCC Construction Official; and


**WHEREAS**, Mayor and Common Council expressed concerns regarding this unsafe structure and have declared same a threat to the public’s health, safety and welfare, and have determined that the property must be demolished in its entirety.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Gloucester City, County of Camden, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. The provisions of the **WHEREAS** clauses set forth above are incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof.
2. A contract is hereby authorized and awarded to Ricco Demolition, located at 282 Creek Road, Bellmawr, NJ 08031 in the amount of \$32,000.00.
3. The Mayor and/or his designee is hereby authorized to execute the subject Contract and take any and all actions necessary to effectuate said purposes.
4. The Chief Financial Officer has determined that funds are available for said work.
