RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXPANSION OF JOB DUTIES FOR POLICE CHIEF BRIAN MORRELL TO INCLUDE ADDITIONAL ADMINISTRATIVE OVERSIGHT DURING THIS TIME OF A DECLARED OFFICIAL STATE OF EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Gloucester City (“City”) has a need for additional administrative oversight regarding supervision of the City’s operations on a daily basis; and


WHEREAS, governmental efficiencies would best be served by expanding the job duties of the Chief of Police to perform such tasks; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Common Council desire to expand the job duties for Police Chief Brian Morrell in the interest of efficient government, especially during this time of a declared State of Emergency by the Governor of the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, Police Chief Brian Morrell possess all the requisite qualifications to assist the City during a nationwide pandemic.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Gloucester City, County of Camden, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. The provisions of the **WHEREAS** clauses set forth above are incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof.
2. The duties and responsibilities of Police Chief Brian Morrell are hereby expanded to include the administrative operational functions set forth in the attached job description.
