## Urban Airshed Reforestation Program Resident Tree Planting Agreement

A tree planting has been planned for your neighborhood. A street tree may be planted in front of your home if you are interested. *If you do not want a tree in front of your home, please do not sign this form.* By filling out this form you are indicating that you have read, understand, and agree to all of the following:

1. **You would like a tree placed in front of your home**
2. After the site has been evaluated by the NJ Tree Foundation, it may be determined to not be suitable for a tree (small sidewalks, utilities, existing trees, etc.)
3. You will maintain your tree by **watering, weeding, mulching, and protecting** it for at least the first 2 years that it is in the ground. **Homeowner accepts responsibility of Tree & existing Curb & Sidewalk.**
4. You agree to participate in the tree planting event in your neighborhood by volunteering and/or being present the day of the tree planting.
5. While the NJ Tree Foundation is a resource for you and your community, ultimately you are responsible for the maintenance of the tree.
6. If the site requires it, the pavement in front of your home will be cut.
7. If you decide to cancel your tree request after signing this form and the pavement has already been cut, you will be responsible for replacing the pavement at your expense. If you change your mind after your tree has been planted, you are responsible for removing the tree.
8. If you are a renter, you understand you must have homeowner permission before signing.
